The course presents the various formal grammars (regular, context-free and context-sensitive). Lexical Functional Grammar (LFG) is more closely examined and applied not only to formal languages but also to French and English data: passive, long distance dependencies, clitics... Some non-configurational languages are also considered.

This course aims at introducing to unification grammars by comparing such formalisms to the transformational approach to syntax.
