Course content

The course provides a survey of the main developments in English-language poetry from its origins to the Romantic period. The course focuses on a reading list including twenty-five representative texts from the Middle Ages, the Renaissance, pre-Romanticism, and Romanticism.

The course aims to make students familiar with major literaryhistorical currents in English poetry on the basis of a sample of canonical texts.
