After an introductory historical overview, this course offers a detailed analysis of significant English Canadian novels or plays from the late 20th century and early 21st century. Students will be required to read an additional Canadian novel of their choice and to prepare a chapter from *The Cambridge Companion to Canadian Literature* for presentation on the day of the oral exam.
