The bachelor's in political sciences offers:

- > An introduction to the various **sub-fields in political science**: international relations, European studies, comparative politics, public administration and political theory;
- > An opening to other fields in humanities: sociology, history, geography, law, economics, etc.;
- > A solid **training in methods**: formalization, statistics, methods, and seminars;
- > A strong emphasis on **multilingual training**: the program includes two mandatory language courses, readings in English in Blocs 1 and 2 and courses in English in Bloc 3. The program can be followed in its bilingual (FR/NL or FR/ANG) or trilingual (FR/NL/ANG) version;
- > An international opening: international exchanges of 1 semester or 1 year in Bloc 3, and international profile of Faculty and students.
