The master's in political science in one year (60 credits) is offered in two versions: The day-time program is fully taught in English. The evening program is fully taught in French.

The day-time program in English offers a complementary training for students who want to deepen their university training.

The **evening program in French** offers a complementary training for students who want to re-orient their career path.

Completing the program (60 credits) will help you in acquiring:

- > An analytical approach based on rigorous methods;
- Advanced knowledge in one specific domain in political science: international relations or EU affairs, politics and government;
- Writing and public speaking skills in English;
- > An **opening** to the world.

Programme's added value

To choose the master's in political science (60 credits) at ULB is:

Choosing for a high-quality additional training and/or professional re-orientation;

- Studying in an internationally renowned department. For the fourth consecutive year, SciencePo ULB was ranked in the Top 100 worldwide.
